Privacy Policy

Lithuanian National Museum of Art (company code: 190756087, address: Didžioji street 4, Vilnius, 01128, Lithuania) is a controller of the personal data you provide to us.

Lithuanian National Museum of Art (“us”, “we”, or “our”) operates the <https://utilityforthesoul.com/> website (“Website”) and the “Utility for the soul” mobile application (“App”).

Here we describe how we collect, use and handle your information when you use our Website and App (“Services”). By using the Services, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

What information we collect?

We collect and use the following information to provide, improve and protect our Services:

1. Usage Data

We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Service or when you access the Service by or through a mobile device (“Usage Data”).

This Usage Data may include information such as IP addresses, the type of browser and device you use, the web page you visited before coming to our sites, and identifiers associated with your devices.

When you access the Service by or through a mobile device, this Usage Data may include information such as the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device unique ID, the IP address of your mobile device, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data. We may also receive information about your location.

Automatically Collected Data:

When you use the Services, the following information is created and automatically logged in our systems:

- Log data: Information (“log data”) that the Apps automatically send when you use them.
- Device information: Includes type of device you are using, operating system, settings, unique device identifiers, network information and other device-specific information. Information collected may depend on the type of device you use and its settings.
- Usage Information: We collect information about how you use our Services, such as the types of content that you view or engage with, the features you use, the actions you take, the other users you interact with and the time, frequency and duration of your activities.

Why such information is collected?

We use Usage Data for various purposes stated in this Privacy Policy, i.e.:

- To provide and maintain the Services.
- To provide analysis or valuable information so that we can improve the Services.
- To monitor the usage of the Services.
- To detect, prevent and address technical issues.

Lawfulness of Processing Data

- Processing of Usage Data is necessary for the performance, installation and use of the App.

Transfer of Data

We may share information as discussed below, but we won't sell it to advertisers or other third parties:

1. *Others working for us*

We use certain trusted third parties (for example, providers of IT services) to help us provide, improve, protect, and promote our Services. These third parties will access usage information only to perform tasks on our behalf in compliance with this Privacy Policy, and we'll remain responsible for their handling of usage information per our instructions.

2. *Law & Order*

We may disclose usage information to third parties if we determine that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to comply with the law.

Usage information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from your jurisdiction.

If you are located outside Lithuania and choose to provide information to us, please note that we transfer the data, including Personal Data, to Lithuania and process it there.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

The App will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of your Usage Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of usage data.

Retention

We will keep your Usage Data for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, while we have a legitimate business need to do so, or as required by law, whichever is the longer.

Children Privacy

Our Service does not address anyone under the age of 13 ("Children").

We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13. If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your Children has provided us with Personal Data, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected Personal Data from Children without verification of parental consent, we take steps to remove that information from our servers.

Your Rights

You have the right to request from us access to and rectification or erasure of Usage Data or restriction of processing concerning you or to object to processing as well as the right to data portability.

If you are not satisfied with our response or believe we are processing your usage data not in accordance with the law you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

Changes

We may update our Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify you of any changes by posting the new Privacy Policy on this page.

You are advised to review this Privacy Policy periodically for any changes. Changes to this Privacy Policy are effective when they are posted on this page.

If we are involved in a reorganization, merger, acquisition or sale of our assets, your information may be transferred as part of that deal. We will notify you by posting on this page.
